
DECLARATION OF COMPLIANCE

MINERAL OIL HYDROCARBONS (MOSH/MOAH)

1. Scope

This declaration applies to corrugated paper and paperboard packaging products manufactured and supplied by Corruseal Corrugated Group, including packaging produced from virgin and recycled fibre grades for food and non-food applications.

2. Declaration

Corruseal Corrugated Group recognises the importance of controlling and managing Mineral Oil Saturated Hydrocarbons (MOSH) and Mineral Oil Aromatic Hydrocarbons (MOAH) in food-contact packaging applications.

Corruseal manages potential MOSH/MOAH risks through approved raw material sourcing, supplier assurance programmes, manufacturing controls and risk-based verification activities.

Corruseal does not make a blanket declaration that its packaging is mineral oil free, as naturally occurring and process-related mineral oil hydrocarbons may be present in paper-based packaging materials, particularly those containing recycled fibre.

3. Risk Management and Control Measures

Corruseal maintains the following controls to minimise potential MOSH/MOAH contamination:

- Approval and ongoing monitoring of raw material suppliers.
- Review of supplier specifications and compliance documentation.
- Controlled manufacturing and converting processes.
- Change-management procedures for raw materials and converting inputs.
- Risk-based verification programmes.
- Product-specific reviews where customer, regulatory or end-use requirements necessitate additional assessment.

These controls form part of Corruseal's broader food safety, quality and supplier assurance systems.

4. Regulatory Position

At the date of issue of this declaration, Corruseal is not aware of any specific PPWR concentration limits applicable to MOSH or MOAH in corrugated packaging.

Where customer specifications, food-contact regulations or product-specific risk assessments require additional evaluation, Corruseal may undertake further assessment, including migration testing or the review of supporting technical documentation, as appropriate for the intended use of the packaging.

5. Customer-Specific Applications

Certain food applications, including direct food-contact, fatty foods, bakery products, confectionery products, pizza packaging and other grease-sensitive applications, may require additional evaluation based on the intended use and customer requirements.

Corruseal will support customer-specific compliance assessments where required through the provision of relevant technical documentation maintained within its compliance management system.

6. Commitment

Corruseal is committed to the continuous improvement of raw material selection, supplier management and food-contact packaging controls in order to minimise potential MOSH/MOAH risks and to support compliance with evolving customer and regulatory requirements.

7. Validity and Authorisation

This declaration is valid for a period of two (2) years from the date of issue unless changes to legislation, raw materials, suppliers, manufacturing processes or product composition require earlier review or revision.
