

PPWR DECLARATION

REGULATION (EU) 2025/40 PACKAGING AND PACKAGING WASTE

1. Scope

This declaration applies to corrugated packaging products manufactured and supplied by Corruseal Corrugated Group for applications where Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste is applicable.

2. Declaration

Corruseal Corrugated Group declares that packaging products supplied by the Corruseal Group are designed, manufactured and controlled in accordance with the applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste.

3. PPWR Compliance Summary

PPWR requirement	Corruseal position
Packaging composition and substances of concern	Packaging is controlled through supplier assurance, approved raw material controls and risk-based verification to manage substances that may adversely affect human health, food safety, recyclability or environmental performance.
PFAS in food-contact packaging	PFAS are not intentionally added during the manufacture of Corruseal corrugated packaging. Applicable PPWR PFAS restrictions are managed through material control and supplier assurance processes.
Heavy metals	The sum of Lead (Pb), Cadmium (Cd), Mercury (Hg) and Hexavalent Chromium (Cr(VI)) in packaging and packaging components does not exceed 100 mg/kg.
Recyclability	Corruseal corrugated packaging is paper-based and designed to support recycling within established paper and board recovery systems, subject to customer specifications and intended application.
Packaging minimisation	Corruseal applies design and manufacturing practices intended to provide packaging functionality while avoiding unnecessary material use, consistent with customer requirements and product protection needs.
Technical documentation	Supporting supplier declarations, specifications, verification records and customer-specific documentation are retained in the technical compliance file.

4. Review Commitment

Corruseal will review this declaration where PPWR implementing guidance, customer requirements, raw materials, suppliers, manufacturing processes or product specifications change.

Validity and Authorisation

This declaration is valid for a period of two (2) years from the date of issue unless changes to legislation, raw materials, suppliers, manufacturing processes or product composition necessitate earlier review or revision.
